This grant totalling £59,978 was awarded in October 2021 to provide funding for a		
new Young Adult Carer (YAC) Education Worker for two years to expand the current		
YAC project, supporting young adult carers to continue in higher/further education		
and training.

Visit Details (People met, premises visited etc.) A Zoom call was arranged with Anne Phillips who is the YAC Education worker, her		
line manager, Karen Keey, the quality and information Manager at SCC and Emma		
Daniels who is Deputy CEO.		
Information about the Organisation		
SCC was formed in April 2005 with the support of the local authority and Age		
Concern to provide a holistic service for all adult carers across Swansea and the surrounding area. Since then, it has grown and offers a wide range of services,		
advice on welfare benefits, financial issues (fuel poverty support) Mental Health		
Wellbeing, Counselling, Getting a break and other support groups for carers.		
The newest support group is for Male carers and the increased diversity in Swansea		
has led to a greater focus on BAME who account for 10% of the population in this		
area.		
In addition to Triangle Trust, SCC has a range of funders including Lloyds Bank, The		
Henry Smith Charity as well as the local authority.		
Issues and Comments		
A very informative call with SCC. Anne		•
Foundation worker and has found that it has been easier to approach colleges rather		
than schools. In part this may be because schoolteachers are so busy with day to		
day teaching and student Mental Health issues caused by the pandemic. However,		
she is persisting and has introduced virtual school assemblies with good results		
helping students allocate their time between study and their responsibilities as carers. She estimates that 1 young person in 12 has a caring responsibility in her		
area.		
Anne has developed a service providir	ng tailored support	, face to face or by phone
and mail and the team host a variety of events specifically for young carers such as		
healthy eating, cookery, sports and 'Feel Good Friday' Zoom sessions.		

She is an extremely capable and knowledgeable team member and has been working hard to instigate a Young Carers policy with the DofE. Anne is a member of a Steering Group which aims to persuade Government to introduce such a policy.

## Other Feedback

The team thanked everyone at Triangle Trust for the support and it was good to witness our grant being of such benefit to young carers in the Swansea and surrounding area.
